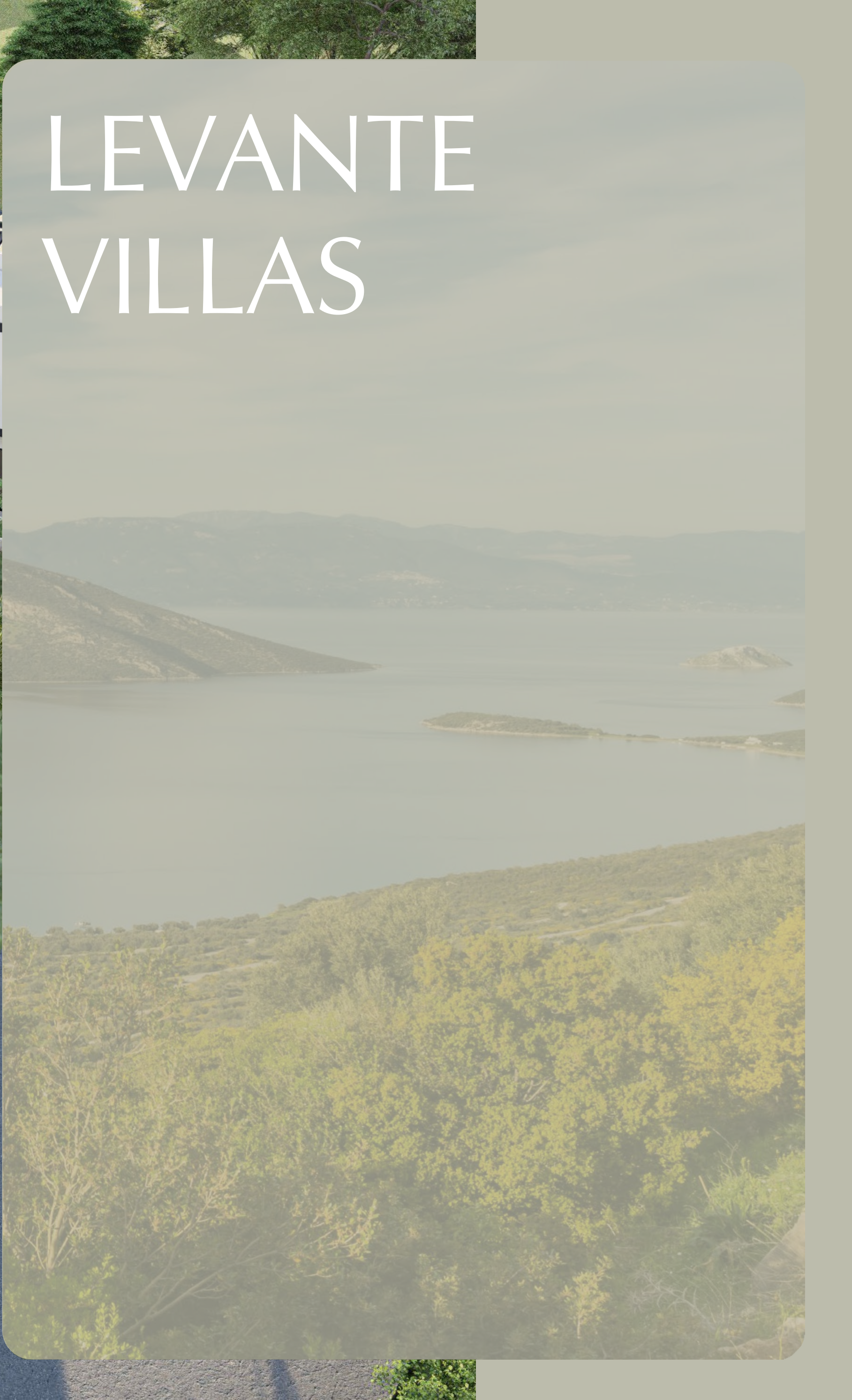

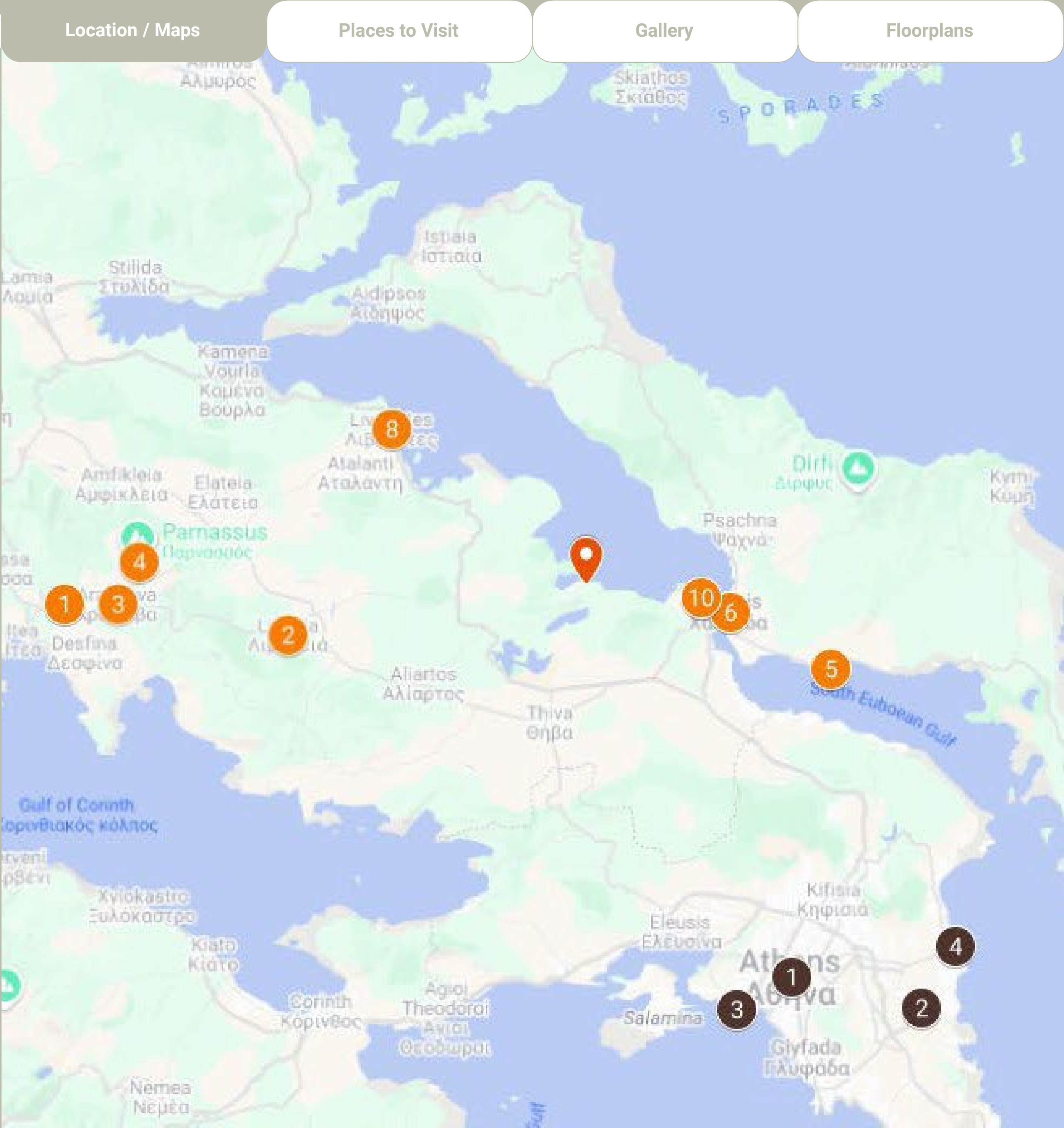

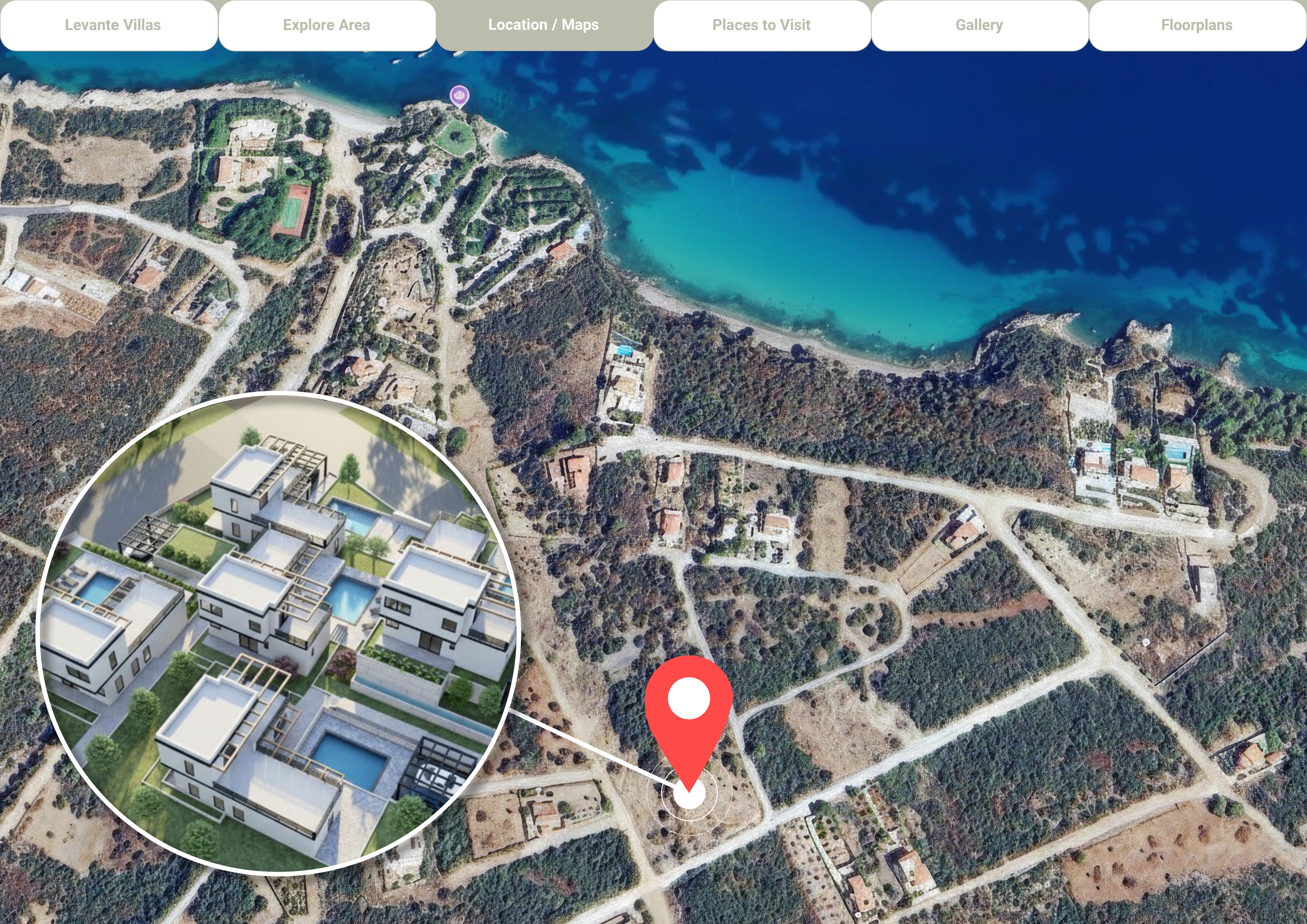

Between Rivers and Recipes

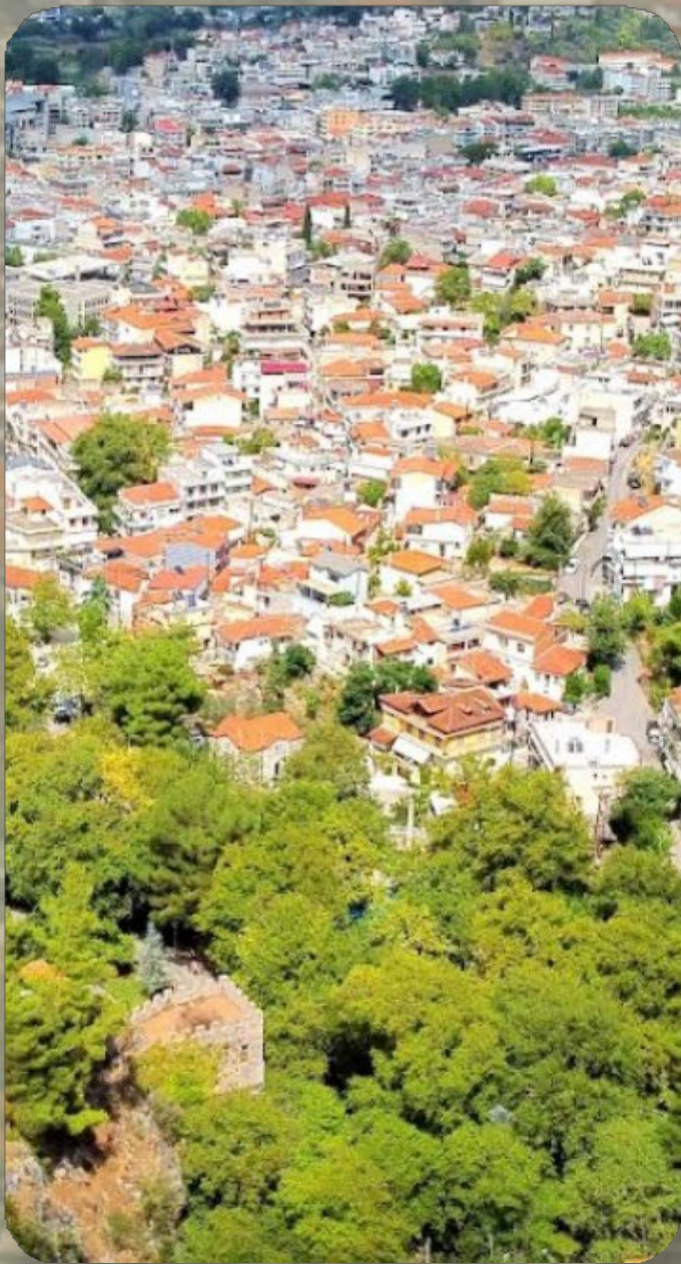
Once home to the ancient Oracle of Trophonius, Livadeia blends myth, history, and natural beauty.

Parnassos

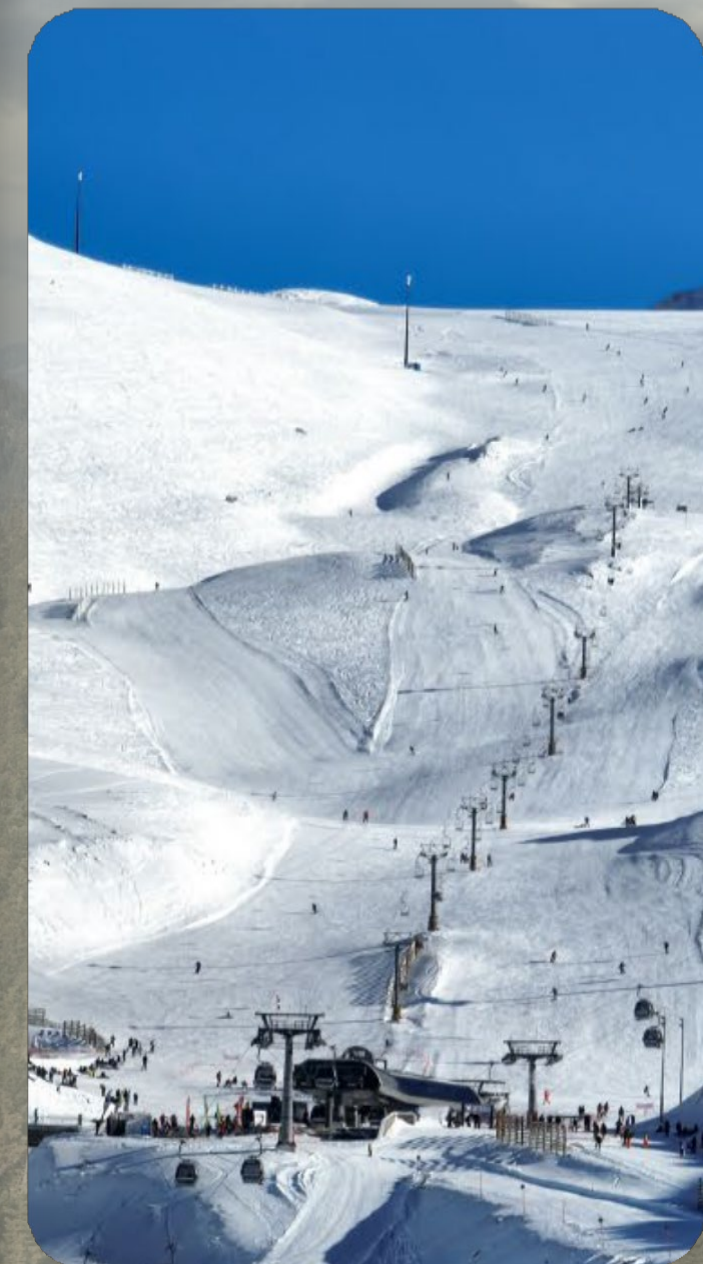
Mountain Elegance

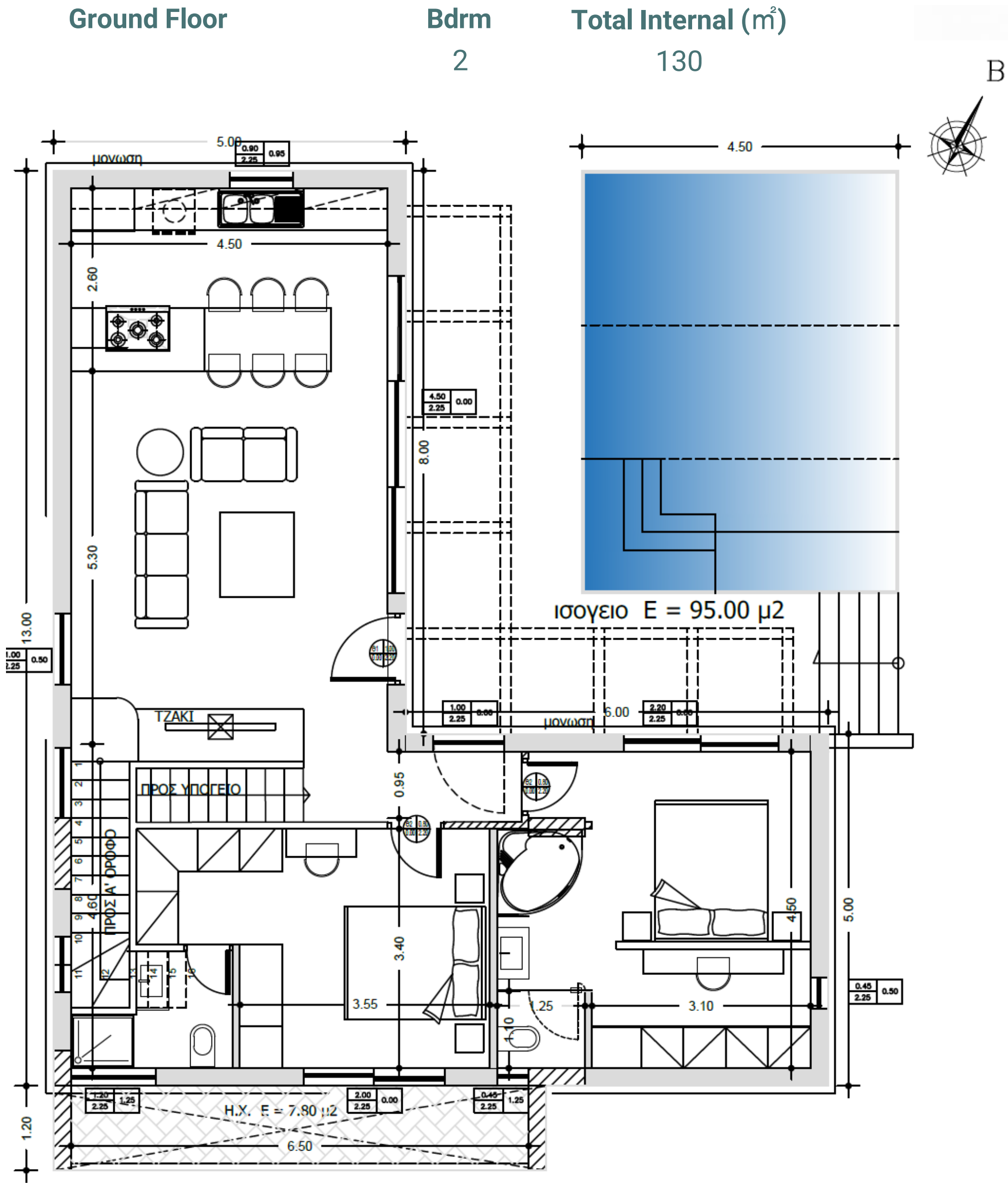
